We, first of all, made sure that each child was economically eligible for the scholarship ascertaining that the child's family earned 250% of the poverty level or less. Each school then distributed the scholarship money in significant awards to those students with the best academic potential. In most cases, those scholarships were bolstered by donations from additional sources to make sure that the total scholarship aid for a student met that student's financial needs.
