Division of Taxation Offices – Closed Monday February 23

PROVIDENCE, R.I. – The Rhode Island Division of Taxation informs taxpayers, tax professionals, and the community that Governor McKee has announced a State of Emergency beginning at 5 p.m. February 22, 2026 due to the predicted severe weather conditions Sunday February 22 through Monday February 23.

The State of Emergency declaration includes the temporary closure of state government on Monday, February 23, 2026. For this reason, the Division of Taxation's offices and operations will be closed Monday, February 23, 2026. In addition to the closure of the building, the phones will be unstaffed, and emails will be delayed.

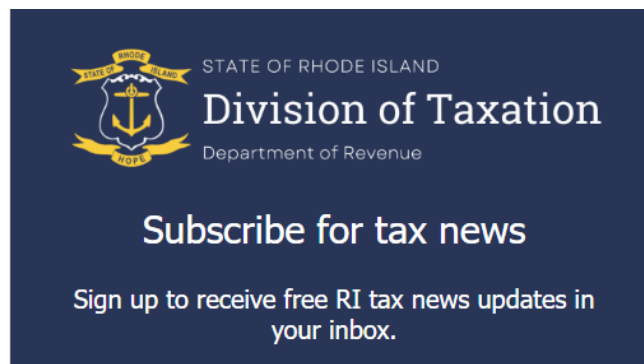
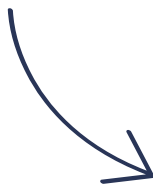
